

RETROFITTING EXISTING KNOXBOXES TO AN eLOCK CORE

Most existing KnoxBoxes you will find installed today can be retrofitted from a mechanical core to a Knox eCore (electronic core). This sheet provides helpful reminders of boxes that can and cannot be retrofitted.

MODELS ELIGIBLE FOR RETROFITTING

- All “hinged door” boxes manufactured after the year 2000 - this includes all KnoxBoxes 1300, 1400, 1650, 3200, 4100, 4400, and 4500.
- All HomeBox models can be retrofitted.
- Other models may also be eligible for retrofitting. See the tips below to confirm eligibility.

TIP 1: CHECK THE SERIAL NUMBER

The following **CAN** be retrofitted

- Any KnoxBox with a serial number with 6 numbers starting with a “2”
- Any KnoxBox with a serial number with 8 numbers starting with a “32-”
- All Hinged Door Model 3200 Series

NOTE: Even if the eLock core fits, it is not guaranteed to work correctly. Please ensure the serial numbers are compatible.

The following **CANNOT** be retrofitted

- Any KnoxBox with a serial number of 5 numbers or less
- Any KnoxBox with a serial number starting with a “Z”
- Any KnoxBox with a serial number starting with a “1”

TIP 2: KNOW VISUAL CUES



If the box does not have a dust cover, it **CANNOT** be retrofitted.

NOTE:

Any KnoxBox product without a dust cover cannot be retrofitted, even if the box is one listed as compatible. The dust cover is required to keep water off the eLock core.



If the box does not have a serial number, it **CANNOT** be retrofitted.

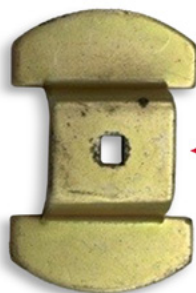
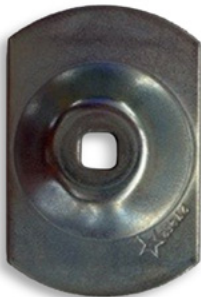


The older KnoxBox 2900 Series **CANNOT** be retrofitted.
