Fire departments across the country utilize the Knox Rapid Access System to prevent costly forced entry damage while protecting lives and property. Knox key vault products such as KnoxBoxes, KnoxVaults and Knox Document Cabinets hold building entrance keys, electronic access cards and vital emergency information, while Knox Gate and Key Switches and Knox Padlocks provide fire department access through property gates. Additional fire and life safety products include Knox FDC Locks which protect the integrity of fire sprinkler systems – the building's first line of defense in case of fire.

As the property owner, enable rapid emergency response by purchasing and mounting the Knox device near your building entrance or property gate according to fire department guidelines. This aids emergency responders immediate access into your property, avoiding unnecessary forced entry. This leading high security, heavy-duty key box is used to gain immediate emergency access into most commercial applications including businesses, schools, government and public buildings, community associations and apartment complexes.

Key vaults store building keys, access cards and floor plans for larger businesses, industrial properties, public buildings and universities.

Colors: Dark bronze, black or aluminum



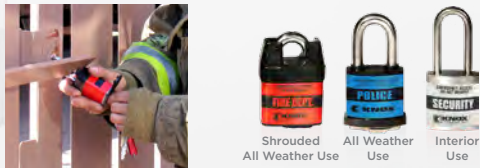

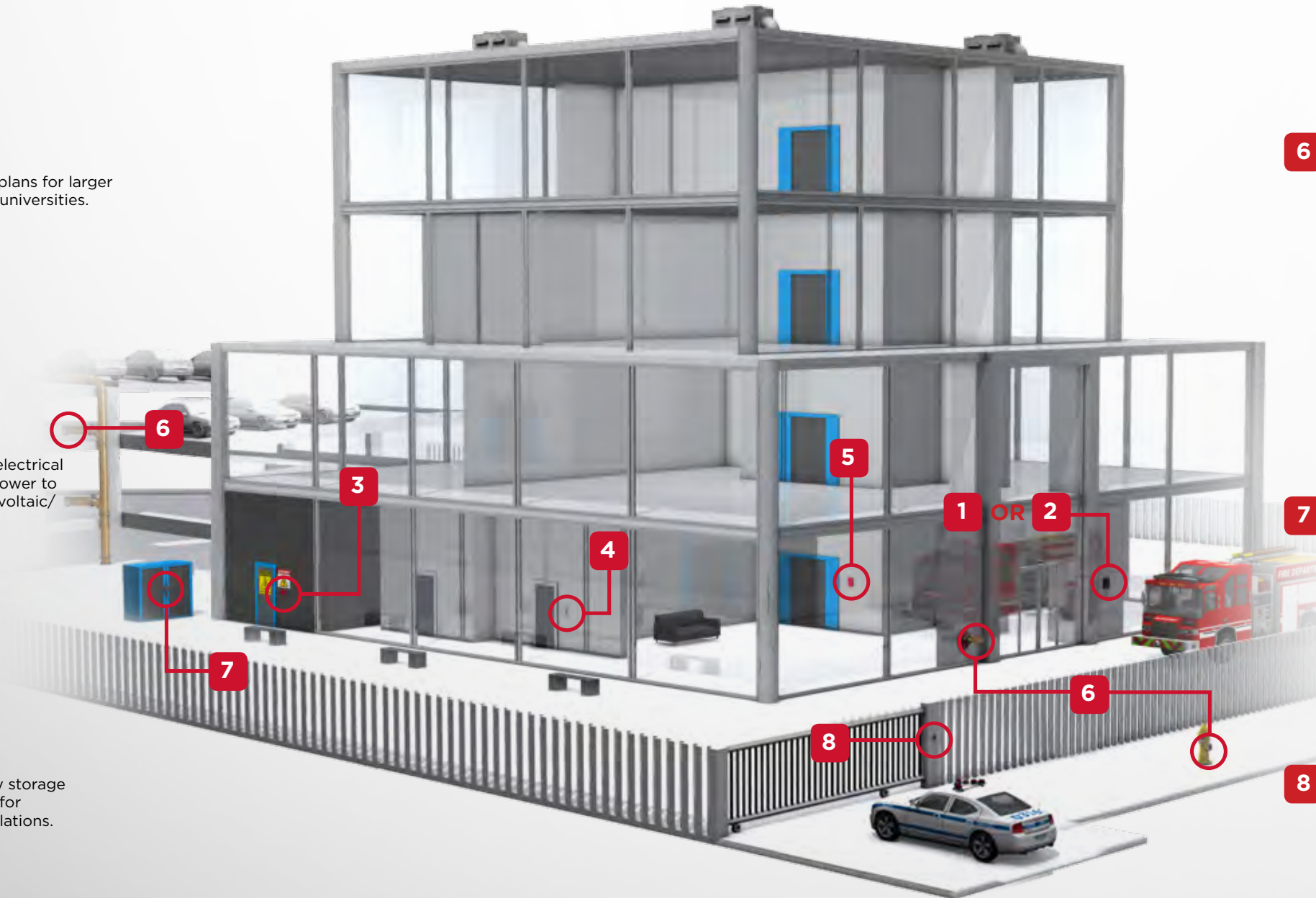
